Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is the difference between Year 1, Year 2, and full membership?

Year 1:

- Fee: £260
- Includes eight group lessons with a professional from Craig Donnelly Golf/Cluny Clays.
- Note: You will not be able to play for a handicap this year.

Year 2:

- Fee: £310
- Includes eight group lessons with a professional from Craig Donnelly Golf/Cluny Clays.
- You will receive a CDH number from Stuart, our Golf Club Manager, allowing you to become a Scottish Golf member, play for a handicap, and track your scores.



2. Gaining a Handicap: (<https://www.scottishgolf.org/whs-education-for-golfers>)

- **Requirements:** Complete 3 x 18 holes, 6 x 9 holes, or a combination.
- **Score Cards:** Ensure your scorecard includes your name, date, score, your signature, and the signature and name of the person who marked the card. Write "HANDICAP" in capital letters on the card.

Note – 1. The individual who signs your card must have an up-to-date handicap.

2. Scores for handicap must be on a course with full greens and off the regulation tees (not winter tees).

3. Scores for handicap played at a different course – please send a photo of your card, including the tee you played from, to the relevant handicap secretary.

3. How do I book a tee time to play on the course?

To book a tee time, download the BRS app on your smartphone. A link will be included in your welcome email, along with your username (4-digit code).



4. When are the lessons?

Lessons are held on Thursdays from:

- 10:30 AM - 11:30 AM
- 6:30 PM - 7:30 PM

There are two sessions: the first starts at the end of April, and the second at the end of June.

5. How do I book the lessons?

Once you join the GIGs, Stuart, Golf Development Manager, will provide us with your name and telephone number. We will then add you to the GIG WhatsApp group for communication. When you receive an invite, you can respond with 'yes' or 'no' for a morning or evening lesson on the weekly poll. If you cannot attend a class you've booked, please update your response to allow others to take your spot.

6. How many are in each class?

Class sizes vary, but the maximum is twelve participants per session.

7. What do I do if I do not have any clubs?

If you don't have clubs, please inform the professional in advance, and he will lend you a club for the lesson. Each week, he will specify which club(s) to bring.

8. What do I wear?

Wear whatever you feel comfortable in! Trainers are acceptable as long as they have a good grip.

Barbara and I will also organize friendly competitions throughout the year to help you meet other members and build your confidence.
